

TRIVIA BEE

Here's how the Trivia Bee works:

- **Teams of three adults and/or high school students compete against each other in rounds.**
- **Each team will have a captain who will write down and give the final answer.**
- **There are six teams per round and six qualifying rounds.**
- **A master of ceremonies (MC) reads trivia questions from the following categories: Arts & Entertainment; History; Science & Nature; Sports; Local Trivia; Name that Tune.**
- **Teams are given time to confer and write their answer on an erasable white board. (All teams in a round answer the same questions.)**
- **When the bell rings, teams display their answers to the judges and audience.**
- **Spelling does not have to be exact, but the answer must be legible and understandable to the judges.**
- **Each team receives a point for a correct answer. No points are taken away for a wrong answer.**
- **Questions may be multiple choice or free response.**
- **Each round consists of 6 questions. The team with the most points at the end of the round advances to the Championship Round. (In case of a tie, there is an exciting sudden death play-off.)**
- **Rules for the Championship Round are the same as for the qualifying rounds. Teams will be given the same question. Answers will be written on white boards by team captains. The grand champion will be the team that succeeds in “sudden death” play. While questions are designed to be a little challenging, the main idea of the Trivia Bee is to have FUN!**
