

TRIVIA BEE

Here's how the Trivia Bee works:

- Teams of three adults and/or high school students compete against each other in rounds.
- Each team will have a captain who will write down and give the final answer.
- There are six teams per round and six or seven qualifying rounds.
- A master of ceremonies (MC) reads trivia questions from the following categories: Arts and Entertainment; History; Sports & Leisure; Easton & vicinity; Nature & Science; Geography and General. Teams are given time to confer and write their answer on an erasable white board. (All teams in a round answer the same questions.)
- When the timekeeper yells “time is up”, teams display their answers to the judges and audience.
- Spelling does not have to be exact, but the answer must be legible and understandable to the judges.
- Each team receives a point for a correct answer. No points are taken away for a wrong answer.
- Questions may be multiple choice or free response.
- Each round consists of 4-6 questions. (The number of questions will be determined before the Bee based on number of teams participating.)
- The team with the most points at the end of the round advances to the Championship Round. (In case of a tie, there is an exciting sudden death play-off.)
- Rules for the Championship Round are the same as for the qualifying rounds except that it is “sudden death”. Teams will be given the same question. Answers will be written on white boards by team captains. Teams will be eliminated as they answer a question wrong. If all teams answer correctly, another question is asked. If all teams answer incorrectly, another question is asked. If one team answers correctly and the others answer incorrectly, the team that answered correctly will be declared the GRAND CHAMPIONS. While questions are designed to be a little challenging, the main idea of the Trivia Bee is to have FUN!
- The grand champion will be the team that succeeds in “sudden death” play. While questions are designed to be a little challenging, the main idea of the Trivia Bee is to have FUN!
